## That You May Believe

What's the purpose of Scripture? John 20:30-31 describes why John wrote his Gospel, and it summarizes the entirety of the Scripture. "Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name" (ESV). In other words, though the Bible only begins to describe what God is like and what he does, the whole point of the Bible is that we can believe in Jesus as the Christ. This is what brings us life.

This is why I've been having brief children's lessons based on the Catechism. It helps the entire congregation, which consists partly of children, to remember what Jesus has done and taught. It puts a little chunk of that teaching into very specific terms that we can take home with us. And to make it easier for us to follow through during the week, we're going to put the portion of the Catechism for the week into the bulletin for your continued reflection, discussion, and growth.

Should Christ's people learn to pray better? We sure should! If you take a poll of people and ask them about their prayer life, virtually everyone will confess to a need to pray more or better. Do specific prayers sometimes seem like a closed book? Notice that we're starting to put the Collect of the Day (the opening prayer which gathers up ideas from all the Scriptures of the week) in the bulletin. If you have doubts about how to pray, walk through the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Collect. You won't go wrong!
